Dear Friends:

After getting the commentary on the Gospel of John back in print, we next wanted to get The First Epistle of Paul the Apostle to the Corinthians back in print. However, the Lord provided and we hope to have the book back in stock by late November.

More and more each day I am assured that the Lord leads us and leads others to us to further His will. This is shown clearly by how we were blessed several months ago. A friend my family has known for years and think the world of came into the office one day and asked if there was anything he could do to help the ministry since he is now retired and looking for ways to fill his day. We prayed about it and decided to add them as one of the missionaries we support.
